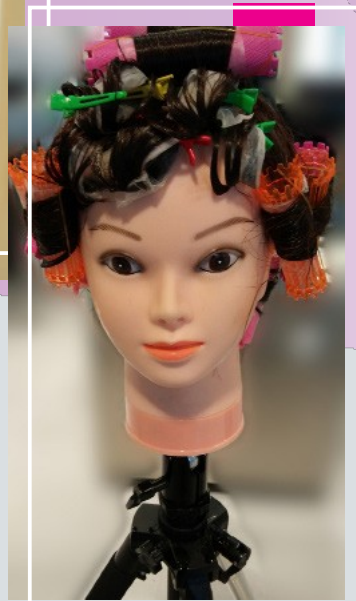

Remark:

1. Applicants are required to submit a personally written hairdressing training course lesson plan (including training syllabus, strategies, objectives, outlines, course content, course materials preparation, training methods, assessment methods, and assessment criteria, etc.) and bring it along for the interview.
2. Applicants are required to submit a personal design portfolio (containing a minimum of 10 pieces of artwork) and bring it along for the interview.
